Lift up your hearts.


We lift them up to the Lord.

Pour out your Holy Spirit on us gathered here, and on these gifts of bread and wine.


Make them be for us the body and blood of Christ, that we may be for the world the body of Christ, redeemed by his blood.



The FFUMC Youth Ministry is committed to inspiring, nurturing and empowering youth to GO into the world as disciples of Christ.

BREAKFAST AT THE FOUNDRY

Explore the story of God and how that story is ours today on Sundays at 9:45 AM.

FOUNDRY FELLOWSHIP

Gather each Wednesday from 6 to 8 PM for games, worship, and topic conversations as we reflect on God's action in the world and our part in it, together.

HANGOUTS, MISSIONS, AND LIFE GROUPS

Youth meet in the community for fun and a deeper dive into what they've been discussing in The Foundry. They also get together for scripture study to ask the hard questions about God's unfolding story. Serving and loving others is a big part of our ministry. Throughout the year, our youth partner with local organizations to participate in God's restorative work. During the summer, we partner with communities farther away on mission trips. Life Groups are supported by adults who care about youth and show up in the community for them.

SENIORS

Adults aged 55+ show up and support ministries throughout the church, but these programs are set aside just for them!

Our seniors meet together each month at noon for food, time together, and a program.

A special yoga class designed to keep you healthy, flexible and connected to others meets once a week.

SEASONED SINGERS

This group gathers to sing each week and presents special music in worship and throughout the community.
