HOW CAN YOU GIVE?

CASH OR CHECK

Cash and checks may be placed in the offering plates during worship or sent to the church office. Offering envelopes are available in the pews, or envelopes for weekly giving are available at the end of each year for the coming year upon request.

PAPERLESS ELECTRONIC GIVING

Electronic giving allows you to have your offering to the church taken directly from your checking or savings account or charged to your credit card and deposited into the church checking account.

Electronic giving can be set up:

ONLINE at *fayettevillefirst.com* by using the "DONATE" button at the bottom of the page or

REALM, our church database system, by logging into *onrealm.org* and going to the "GIVING" tab in your personal Realm account.

The funds will be withdrawn on the day or days you choose, using a payment method you choose, as a one-time donation or ongoing donations.

If you choose a credit card as your method of payment, please consider covering the processing costs of this convenience. The church will incur the cost if you do not choose to do so, reducing the usable amount of your gift. Processing costs vary, calculated based on amount and type of credit card used.

STOCKS

Stock donations are accepted by the church to fulfill a pledge or to contribute to other projects.

ENDOWMENT

The Legacy Giving Endowment Fund offers members and friends the opportunity to include the church in present and future financial plans. Many options are available to make a gift to this fund such as cash, securities, property, bequests, trusts, life insurance and gift annuities. All gifts are invested in established trust accounts with the Georgia United Methodist Foundation. The income from investments is used to fund ministries, building needs and church programs.
