

"Merry Advent!" by Rev. John Barnes

"Merry Christmas!" O wait, am I supposed to say that? Am I allowed to say that? Not, of course, because it might offend someone or is not politically correct, but because it's not Christmas yet! Christmastide in the Christian year starts on December 25 and finishes on Epiphany, January 6, when we celebrate the wise men worshiping the Christ child. This year Advent starts on Sunday, December 2, and ends on Christmas Eve.

Advent is a time of preparation for Christmas. Advent and the scriptures used in the lectionary during Advent remind us of three things: 1) that Jesus came long ago that first Christmas day; 2) that one day in the future Jesus will come again to judge and reign; and 3) Jesus is among us now through the Holy Spirit.

During Advent we remember that

Jesus came; that's why we have crèches and decorate the church with greenery. But you may not realize that we also talk about Jesus' return during Advent. In one of the lectionary Gospel readings Jesus tells the disciples:

But about that day or hour [when I return] no one knows, neither the angels in heaven, nor the Son, but only the Father. Watch, keep alert; for you do not know when the time will come (Mark 13:32-33).

Jesus is coming back so be ready for when he comes—even though we don't know when. Jesus says "be ready" and Advent is about being ready. Maybe we ought to start saying, right after Thanksgiving, "Merry Advent" as a way to help people be ready, be watching. Watching, not for Christmas and gift giving, but for Jesus' return. "Merry Advent!"
