
### CAPITAL CAMPAIGN MOVES FORWARD

The campaign began with a goal of \$350,000. Donations totaling \$205,653.90 have been received which leaves \$144,346.10 outstanding. Any additional funds would be placed in the trustee reserve account to replenish funds that were used to make unexpected repairs. 
Construction on the youth space is progressing. The demo phase is complete. Now the fun part of seeing it begin to
