BIG IDEA: WHAT A BEAUTIFUL NAME

BIG POINT: I BELIEVE IN THE POWER OF JESUS' NAME

BIG WORD: SALVATION IS FOUND IN NO ONE ELSE, FOR THERE IS NO OTHER NAME UNDER HEAVEN GIVEN TO MANKIND BY WHICH WE MUST BE SAVED. ACTS 4:12 (NIV)

LEARNING OUTCOMES:

At the conclusion of this lesson children will:

- Discover that Jesus rose again proving His victory over death.
- understand that Jesus' name is above all names.
- Know that there is power in Jesus' name.



OLDER CHILDREN AND PRETEENS RECOMMENDED FOR AGES 9-12

Use this KDG outline to prepare an impacting small group time for you and your children.

CONNECT TIME

Ask the person next to you what one of their hobbies are, then ask the person sitting on the other side.

THE BIG QUESTION

GROUP DISCUSSION

1. What does your name mean? What does the name 'Jesus Christ' mean?

Invite the children to share what the meaning of their name is if they know it.

The name 'Jesus' itself isn't actually a special name on its own. The name 'Christ' means 'the anointed one', it sets Jesus apart as God's son, The Saviour who takes away the sin of the world. It is a very special name. The name of Jesus is significant because of who it represents, and it is important because of what it means. Philippians 2:9-10 (NLT), "Therefore, God elevated him to the place of highest honour and gave him the name above all other names, that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow." His name is powerful!

2. How did Jesus show power over sin and death?

After Jesus died on the cross His body was placed in a tomb and three days later, He rose again! Jesus rose again showing His ultimate power over sin and death. The single most important victory of all time. Jesus' victory, His power over sin and death, is why we have faith.

3. Why do we say "In Jesus' name, amen" at the end of our prayers?

The Name of Jesus is the most powerful name. Jesus' name is a super force that moves mountains and changes lives. John 14:13 (NIV), "And I will do whatever you ask in my name, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son. You may ask me for anything in my name, and I will do it." When we pray and ask in accordance with His will and with faith, Jesus' name is a powerful force! There is power in Jesus' name.

ACTIVITY SHEETS

Children complete the activity sheets in this time.

THE BIG ACTIVITY

SUPPLIES NEEDED:

Blank stickers, marker.

DIRECTIONS:

Before the lesson write the names of famous people (who the children would know about) onto blank stickers.

Play a game of 'Who am I?' by placing the stickers on children's backs and set children the challenge to find out the name that's stuck to their back by asking one another questions about who it could be. Children can't tell one another the names, they must only answer questions with "Yes" or "No" e.g. Is it a female? Is the person an actor? Is the person a singer? etc.

EXPLANATION:

Jesus' name is probably the most famous name in the world, since Jesus first appeared two thousand years ago, His name has echoed through history, inspiring millions and bringing hope to all corners of the earth! I believe in the power of Jesus' name.



BIG POINT: I BELIEVE IN THE POWER OF JESUS' NAME

A space for you, the leader, to write notes, plans, reminders, things to follow up on or remember for next time.

Before the lesson write out the Big Word in big letters on a plain sheet of paper. Cut it into pieces and hide them around the room.

Tell the children the boundaries of where the Big Word pieces are hidden and send them on a hunt to find and work as a team to put them in order of the Big Word. If you have a larger group of children, you can make two sets of the Big Word in different colours and divide the children into colour teams as a competition to see which team can find and arrange the verse first.

SUPPLIES NEEDED: Game board printed from print material files (1 for each pair), Pens or markers.

In pairs, the children can play a game of Worm. The aim of the game is to avoid closing any boxes by taking turns to add to the worm. Draw horizontal or vertical lines only to form a continuous line without branches or crossing over from one part of the worm to another. The player that cannot connect the worm to an adjacent dot without forming a square, loses the game.
